


Great Dwellings homes must be welcoming and one-of-a-kind, with well-crafted furniture and memorable details.

- Decorate rooms with complementary pieces. Furniture or decor from different brands or time periods can add personality to a space.
- Tie each room together with a color palette or aesthetic. For example, you can coordinate bedding with throw pillows of a similar hue.
- Anchor a room with statement pieces, that add more details. Center a room around an eye-catching piece of art before supplementing it with other items.









The details in your home tell a story and inspire the people who stay in it:

- Make your house feel like a home. Sterile spaces can seem uninviting. Fill your space with art and memories so it feels welcoming and well-loved.
- Incorporate collections or mementos. Invite guests to explore your home or connect with the area by displaying pieces that spark curiosity, like a record collection or painting from a local artist.
- Create eye-pleasing contrasts. Not every details needs to match. Try
 combining solids with patterns, or mixing vintage and modern pieces
 to add a sense of history and depth.









Rooms don't feel empty or cramped, and everything visible is a design details or useful to guests.

- Create a clutter-free environment. Organize cables or tuck them behind furniture. Use ottomans or baskets to store blankets, remotes, or other small items
- Give guests ample storage space and room for movement. Provide somewhere for guests to put their belongings. Avoid blocking entryways, and leave space alongside beds
- Create a sense of openness in tighter and darker spaces. For example, mirrors and bright colors can create the illusion of more space in smaller rooms









The function and layout of each room is carefully considered.

- Arrange areas for activity. For example, if you live near water, placing
 a basket of beach towels near the door can help guests easily find
 what they need.
- Make rooms feel welcoming. Offer enough seating at the table or in the family room so there's space to gather. Rugs, pillows, and throw blankets also add warmth.
- Create ambiance with lighting. Avoid harsh overhead lighting.
 Instead, multiple light sources such as lamps or sconces give guests the option to adjust the mood.

- Furnish with durable, high-quality pieces. For example, a heavy wooden chairs adds character and will last for years. Flea markets or antique stores are great places to start.
- When possible, choose sturdy, natural materials. Materials like stones, wood, and wool look and feel more refined and hold up better against stains or damage.
- Feature a current or timeless style. Whether your home is modern or classic, bohemian or rustic, choose well-designed pieces that can stand the test of time.









Passage Door Handles

When using a Wifi lock or deadbolt, a non-lockable handle, a "Passage Lock", is required. This avoids lockouts and has other benefits.

We prioritize the security of our properties and the convenience of guests. As such, we require that all entrance doors have pass-through door handles rather than Entry locks. Here's why:


1. Prevents Lockouts

Guests may unintentionally lock an entry lock when they leave the property, then find themselves unable to re-enter upon return because they only have the code or key for the deadbolt. Passage handles eliminate this problem.














Passage Door Handles



Bedrooms



Great Dwellings listings must offer at least one private bedroom (or studio) for guests. Each bedroom must have:

- Comfortable bed(s) that accommodates the size of the room
 - Each bed requires two (2) to four (4) pillows (twin/sofa = 2, full/queen/king
 = 4), a duvet insert, two (2) duvet covers, three (3) sheets & pillowcases,
 and a mattress and pillow protectors (All in color WHITE)
- Empty closet or dresser for storing clothes
- Thoughtful touches such as decorative pillows and artwork
- A bedside table, and outlets and/or charging dock near the bed
- Throw blanket (1 per bed)
- Clothes hangers (10 pcs. per bedroom)
- Luggage rack
- Pack -n- Play crib (if interested in accommodating families)
